1. Name

The name of the club shall be:

Wexford Recreational Soccer Club, including SETU Soccer Society Wexford

2. Purpose

The purpose of the club is:

- To promote participation in soccer among students in SETU.
- To organise training sessions and friendly matches.
- To build a foundation for future competitive participation. *(To Be Updated)*
- To promote teamwork, inclusivity, and sportsmanship.

3. Membership

1. Membership is open to all currently enrolled to South East Technological University.
2. All members must follow college policies and the club Code of Conduct.
3. Membership fees €4.00 per academic year will apply

4. Governance (Founding Year Structure)

1. For the academic year *(To Be Updated)*, the club will operate under a **Founding Chair structure**.
2. The Founding Chair will be responsible for:
 - Administration
 - Communication with the college/student union
 - Financial oversight (in line with college rules)
 - Organising sessions and activities
3. Additional committee roles may be appointed if volunteers come forward. *(To Be Updated)*
4. A full committee will be elected at the first Annual General Meeting in the following academic year.

5. Elections

1. An Annual General Meeting (AGM) will be held in start of the next academic year to elect a full committee.
2. All registered members will be eligible to vote.
3. Positions to be elected will include Chair, Treasurer, Coaching staff, sport official staff, head of media among others. The same person can have multiple roles.

6. Finance

1. All funds will be managed in accordance with college/student union regulations.
2. Funds may only be used for club-related purposes.
3. Financial records will be maintained and made available if required by the college.

7. Code of Conduct

All members must:

- Respect teammates, opponents, and staff.
- Follow college policies and safeguarding guidelines.
- Promote equality and inclusivity.
- Avoid misconduct on and off the field.

Disciplinary procedures will be developed as the club grows. *(To Be Updated)*

8. Amendments

This constitution may be amended in the future by a majority vote at a General Meeting. *(To Be Updated)*

9. Dissolution

If the club is dissolved, any remaining funds will be handled in accordance with college policy.
